Broker back on his bike for charity

Blue Zinc mortgage broker Denver Beven climbed onto his bike again this year to take part in the Tour de Cure, an annual charity ride aimed at raising money for cancer research.

Beven joined a team of 26 riders on a nine-day, 1,200km cycle from Melbourne to Sydney from 31 March to 8 April.

At the time of going to print, this year's race had outperformed the 2007 ride with more than \$450,000 raised.

Beven said the target for 2008 was to raise more than \$600,000 and urged *Australian Broker* readers and all brokers to donate to this worthy cause.

Last year, the money raised from the Tour de Cure funded the inaugural 'Fighting Prostate Cancer' Round Table regional conference, sponsored the latest technology for breast tissue research and analysis, and enabled 151 children with cancer to attend Camp Quality's camps where laughter is the best medicine.

In 2007, Beven was one of 30 cyclists who set out from Brisbane and rode to Sydney in the Inaugural Tour de Cure. The \$400,000 raised was put towards finding a cure for cancers affecting men, women and children. •
