Greyhound Australia supports Tour de Cure

\$1 from every ticket sold 14-21 March will be donated to the fight against cancer

Greyhound Australia is back on the road with Tour de Cure for this year's Signature Tour from Hobart to Adelaide starting Friday.

Two Greyhound coaches will accompany 187 riders and support crew from 16-23 March, with the tour aiming to raise \$2 million for the fight against cancer.

Tour de Cure is a cancer agnostic not for profit, and funds Australian cancer research projects along with support and prevention projects around the country.

To further support the cause Greyhound will donate \$1 from every ticket sold 14-21 March, said Greyhound Australia CEO Dan Smith.

"We are honoured to continue our partnership with Tour de Cure to bolster the fantastic work they do in the areas of cancer research and support," he said.

It marks the seventh year of the partnership since Greyhound jumped onboard in 2017, said Tour de Cure CEO Simon Rountree.
